## SUBJECT:

Front seat belts may be slow to retract.

## **OVERVIEW:**

This bulletin involves installing a shield to cover the B pillar wire harness and isolate it from the seat belt webbing.

# **MODELS:**

1999 - 2000 (WJ) Grand Cherokee

# SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The seat belt webbing may come in contact with the wire harness causing the belt to retract slowly.

## **DIAGNOSIS:**

Remove the seat belt access cover from the B Pillar trim panel and inspect the seat belt for contact with the wire harness (See Figure 1). If contact is evident, perform the Repair Procedure.



## REPAIR PROCEDURE:

THIS REPAIR IS COMPATIBLE WITH DAIMLERCHRYSLER'S MOBILE SERVICE PROGRAM AND DOES NOT REQUIRE HOISTS OR OTHER FULL SERVICE FACILITY SPECIAL EQUIPMENT.

1. Remove the B Pillar trim panel (See Figure 1).

2. Install the shield, p/n 55116545AB, into the opening by inserting the tabs one at a time.

3. Install the trim panel
